**Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether there is any scheme for opening ITIs at district level for promoting technological education in country;
- (b) if so, whether the Government has issued certain guidelines and provided financial assistance for opening new ITIs in the country particularly in Karnataka State;
- (c) if not, whether the Government propose to provide the funds directly for opening such institutions;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF LABOUR & EMPLOYMENT (SHRI MALLIKARJUN KHARGE)

a) to e) Directorate General of Employment & Training (DGE&T), Ministry of labour & Employment is formulating a scheme titled "Kaushal Vikas Yojana (KVY)" for setting up 1500 new Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) and 5000 Skill Development Centers (SDCs) in Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode throughout the country for promoting skill development. 'In-Principle' approval has been granted by Planning Commission. Approval process for the scheme is on.

As the scheme is under approval, detail guidelines and financial assistance are yet to be finalised. The scheme will cover all the States and UTs including State of Karnataka.

Mode of providing financial assistance will be finalised during approval of the scheme.
