VACANT POSTS IN PSBS

- (a) whether there is shortage of staff in the Public Sector Banks (PSBs) in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of posts in various grades lying vacant in PSBs during the last three years; and
- (d) the action taken by the Government to fill up the vacant posts in the PSBs?

Answer

(a),(b)&(c) : The information is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the House.

(d): In terms of the managerial autonomy granted to the public sector banks (PSBs) by the Government, full operational & managerial autonomy has been given to the PSBs; which includes framing of their own "Human Resources" policies & procedures, manpower planning and recruitment. The filling up of the vacancies is an ongoing exercise and the PSBs make their recruitment as per their needs and requirements.
