- (b) whether India has friendly relations with these countries;
- (c) if so, whether the Prime Minister proposes to visit these countries for strengthening bilateral relations; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a)to(d) The Government of India maintains friendly relations with each and every country. With the aim to develop and consolidate these relations, the Head of State/Government undertake bilateral visits to these countries. In this context, successive Indian Prime Ministers have, since 1947, visited a large number of countries. At the same time, visits by Heads of State and Heads of Government are also undertaken to India. Besides bilateral visits, the Prime Minister also meets his counterparts in various multilateral summits and meetings to discuss bilateral relations with these countries and steps as necessary to take them forward.
