(a) to (e) Sovereignty over areas of the South China Sea (SCS) is disputed between many countries in the region, including China. India is not a party to this dispute. Government's position is that sovereignty issues in the SCS must be resolved peacefully by the countries which are parties to the dispute in accordance with international law and practice.
