The State Govt. of Himachal Pradesh has submitted a scheme namely, `Swan River Flood Management & Integrated Land Development Project (Phase-II)` in District Una (HP) amounting to Rs. 184.27 Cr. for consideration of the Empowered Committee on Flood Management Programme for providing central assistance (Central Share-90%: State Share-10%). The Scheme has been considered by the Empowered Committee during its meeting held on 10th July, 2009.
