(a) & (b): As per the Approach Paper for the 12th Five Year Plan, it is envisaged to increase R&D expenditure to 2% of GDP by the end of the 12th Plan. This could consist of about 1% in the public sector and 1% in the corporate sector, including PSUs. At present, the resources devoted to R&D by our large public sector organizations are far too small.
