(a) & (b): The employment opportunities in Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs), during the last three years, based on the Public Enterprises Survey (2009-10) that was laid in the Parliament on 24.2.2011 is given below (Table):

The Table above provides the information on the permanent employees (excluding the contract workers). The reasons for decline in the number of permanent employees, during the last three years, have been superannuation and Voluntary Retirement Scheme (VRS) in CPSEs.
