- (a) whether Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Ltd. has proposed a Rs. 25,000 crore investment plan to relocate the 6.5 million tonnes per annum refinery in Mumbai with a grass root refinery at Ratnagiri in coastal Maharshtra;
- (b) if so, the details of financing of the project alongwith the number of jobs to be created with the setting up of the new refinery;
- (c) the total number of HPCL petroleum and gas outlets in Maharashtra with district wise break up; and
- (d) the details of more outlets expected to be set up in Latur area during the next three years?

- (a) & (b): Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Ltd. (HPCL) has commissioned a study on pre project activities for a 9 MMTPA grassroot refinery at Ratnagiri district in the State of Maharashtra.
- (c) HPCL has a total of 1137 Retail outlets and 464 LPG distributors in the State of Maharashtra. District wise break up is given at Annexure.
- (d) HPCL plans to set up 10 retail outlets in Latur district during the current year and next three years.
