(a) to (c) No, Madam. At present Government does not propose to set up new National Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research (NIPER) in the country. In 1998, National Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research was set up at Mohali (Punjab). Union Government approved establishment of Six New NIPERs one each at Gandhinagar (Gujarat), Hajipur (Bihar), Hyderabad (Andhra Pradesh), Kolkata (West Bengal), Raebareli (Uttar Pradesh) and Guwahati (Assam). In these New NIPERs courses were started in 2007 and 2008.
