USOF is in the process of finalizing a scheme to provide mobile communication services in about 37184 villages in the country which do not have any wireless mobile coverage. Provisioning of mobile communication services to villages/areas as per above mentioned proposals received from the State Governments will be considered while finalizing the scheme.
