- (d) the funds allocated for construction of PBK; and
- (e) the time by which it will be completed?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF OVERSEAS INDIAN AFFAIRS (SHRI VAYALAR RAVI)

- (a): Yes Sir.
- (b)&(c): The Pravasi Bharatiya Kendra (PBK) will be located on Rizat Marg, Chanakyapuri, New Delhi. It will serve as a Centre to commemorate and celebrate the contributions of the diverse Indian Diaspora to Global Society. The Kendra would over time become the focal point for interactions social, cultural and economic with and between all Overseas Indians. It will also serve as a research and documentation centre and host permanent exhibitions.
- (d): The estimated cost of the PBK is Rs. 79.19 crore.
- (e): The Pravasi Bharatiya Kendra (PBK) project is scheduled to be completed by 30.04.2013.
