Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of projects undertaken under Pradhan Mantri Grameen Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) in Bihar during the last three years and the present status of those projects, district-wise including Gopalganj;
- (b) the details of projects that have been completed;
- (c) the details of projects that have not yet been started together with the reasons therefor;
- (d) the details of projects awarded to Central Government agencies alongwith the status of those projects; and
- (e) the action taken by the Government against the agencies that have not started the work yet?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI PRADEEP JAIN 'ADITYA')

(a)to(c): A total of 5,885 road works were undertaken in the State of Bihar during the years 2008-09, 2009-2010 & 2010-11, out of which 1,085 road works have been completed by the State. State is taken as a unit for sanction of projects so district-wise data is not maintained at the NRRDA level. A total of 346 road works including those awarded to Central Agencies, have not been started yet.

(d)&(e): 1,328 road works were awarded to Central Agencies during the years 2008-09, 2009-2010 & 2010-11, out of which 551 road works have been completed and 673 road works are at different stages, and 104 road works have been transferred to Rural Works Department, Govt of Bihar.
