- (a) and (b): The timings of Air India services between Delhi and Allahabad has recently been changed w.e.f. 23.11.2011. The Delhi-Allahabad flight now departs from Delhi at 1410 hours and Allahabad-Delhi flight departs at 1625 hours on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. On Tuesdays Thursdays and Saturdays the Delhi-Allahabad flights departs at 1105 hours and Allahabad-Delhi flights departs at 1320 hours.
- (c): No, Madam,
- (d): Does not arise.
- (e): At present yield (fare) and capacity utilisation (seat factor), the flight is earning revenue of Rs.85 lakhs per month.
