1. Commencement of 'Forward e-auction' for actual consumers for meeting their long term requirement.	Ministry of Coal has requested CIL to furnish the features of the Scheme and to prepare road map for various activities including road shows, etc. proposed to be conducted.
2. Publishing guidelines for Mine Closure for adoption by coal companies.	The guidelines for mine closure for adoption by coal companies are under finalization.
3. Commissioning of First Unit (125 MW) of the Barsingsar Mine-cum-Thermal Power project of NLC in Rajasthan.	The erection works are in progress. File related to the Revised Cost Estimates (RCE) proposal has been submitted for approval of Finance Minister.
4. Securing CCEA approval for setting up of Empowered Committee of Secretaries to consider the proposals of Coal India Limited for investment abroad.	The Government is considering the proposal for setting up of an Empowered Committee of Secretaries to consider the proposals of CIL for investment abroad. The committee of Secretaries has recommended it and the Cabinet Note is being put up to CCEA for approval. beyond its financial powers of Rs.1000 crore.
5. Publishing guidelines for Underground Coal gasification projects.	The approved guidelines for conducting Underground Coal Gasification (UCG) and for allocation of coal blocks for UCG projects.
