- (a) & (b) During the current year (upto 31.10.2011), the Directorate of Enforcement has issued 117 Show Cause Notices involving an amount totaling to Rs. 2246.31 lakhs in respect of Hawala transactions in contravention of the provisions of the Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999 (FEMA).
- (c) The Directorate of Enforcement takes appropriate action under FEMA on the basis of specific information.
