(a),(b)&(c) The stretch of Gwalior-Bhind-Madhya Pradesh Border has been included in NHDP-IVA for development to two lane with paved shoulder for which feasibility study is in progress and at present there is no proposal for 4-laning of this section. Besides, two proposals (i) widening to two lane in Km.36/00 to Km.48/00 (ii) Strengthening & raising in Km.60/00 to Km.78/00 in the State of Uttar Pradesh have been included in Annual Plan of 2009-10. However, the proposals have not been received from the State Government.
