CONTINGENCY PLAN TO TACKLE TERROR AND DISASTERS

**Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details of contingency plan prepared by the Government to tackle terror and other disasters in the country, airport-wise;
- (b) whether the Bureau of Civil Aviation Security (BCAS) inspects airports and reviews the contingency plans of airports in the country, and
- (c) if so, the details of inspections carried out by BCAS during each of the last three years, airport-wise?

**Answer**

(a): The following types of Contingency Plan are prepared for tackling terror and other disasters at the airports in the country:-

(i) Contingency Plan to deal with hijacking situations.

(ii) Bomb Threat Contingency Plan.

(iii) Counter Terrorist Contingency Plan.

(iv) Emergency Plans for other disasters.

(b) & (c): BCAS carries out annual inspection to review the contingency plans of the airports to deal with hijack situations and bomb threat. Details of the inspections and audits carried out airport-wise by BCAS during 2009, 2010 and 2011 are annexed.
