(a) to (c): The work of improvement to riding quality from km 61 to km 69 and construction of PCC pavement in km 75, in Karja-Muzaffarpur Section are in progress and likely to be completed by December, 2009 and July, 2009 respectively. Improvement in km 70-74 is proposed to be taken up during current Financial Year 2009-10.
