- (b): The Committee of Privileges, in their Second Report laid on the Table of House in November, 2011 had recommended placement of the Members of Parliament at Sl. No. 17 instead of Sl. No. 21 in the Table of Precedence. The recommendations of the Committee are under consideration of the Government.
- (c) to (d): The Committee of Privileges, in their Second Report laid on the Table of House in November, 2011 had recommended issue of notification under Central Motor Vehicles rules, 1989 permitting use of red light beacon atop the vehicles of Members of Parliament. The recommendation of the Committee is being examined by the Government.
