Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether the film industry is facing great challenge from large scale piracy;
- (b) If so, the details of the losses suffered by the film industry due to piracy during each of the last three years and the current year; and
- (c) the steps taken to curb piracy in the said industry?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION & BROADCASTING (DR. S. JAGATHRAKSHAKAN)

- a) Yes, Sir.
- b) Film Industry has been suffering losses on account of piracy. However, there is no definitive data on the quantum of loss arising out of piracy.
- c) Pursuant to the decision arrived at the 27th SIMCON (State Information Ministers Conference) held in December, 2009, a Committee on Piracy was constituted. The Committee in its report has recommended number of measures which has been circulated among all the stakeholders for implementation. Ministry of I&B is also formulating a scheme for launching Multi-media Awareness Campaign to educate the people to desist from buying and consuming pirated production services, as recommended by the said Committee.
