- (a) & (b): Planning Commission provides statewise allocations of
- (i) Normal Central Assistance under the Gadgil-Mukherjee formula,
- (ii) Special Plan Assistance and
- (iii) Special Central Assistance for Hill Areas. Releases to States under these schemes is made by the Ministry of Finance. Adjustments in Normal Central Assistance based on actual utilization by the States are also undertaken by Ministry of Finance.

Statewise releases under Centrally Sponsored Schemes, as well as monitoring their utilization by each State, is undertaken by the Central Government Ministry implementing the scheme. Details of funds disbursed, and utilized from these schemes, statewise, are available only with the Central Government Ministries concerned.
