(a)&(b) With the objective to universalize access to secondary education and improve its quality, a new centrally sponsored scheme called "Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan" was launched in March, 2009. Since inception of the scheme, opening of new 9676 secondary schools (Classes IX-X) and strengthening of existing 35547 secondary schools has been approved. Further, several centrally sponsored schemes including Model School, Girls' Hostel, National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship and Incentive to Girls for Secondary Education have also been launched during the 11th Plan.
