- (a) & (b) Chinese Foreign Minister Yang Jiechi visited New Delhi on 29 February-1 March, 2012. He held extensive discussions on bilateral, regional and global issues with the External Affairs Minister. They also discussed the agenda and outcome of the BRICS Summit due to take place in New Delhi in March 2012. During the talks, the two sides agreed to promote provincial and local-level cooperation between India and China and to establish a dialogue on Maritime Cooperation to strengthen policy coordination on maritime issues. The visiting Foreign Minister also called on the Vice President and the Prime Minister.
