### Will the Minister of MINORITY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) Whether it is a fact that when compared to the enrolment figures, only one out of each 4.55 enrolled muslim child in classes I-VII and one out of every 7.7 muslim child in the entire age group obtains a scholarship;

(b) If so, the details thereof compared to the last three years also, year-wise; and

(c) the steps being taken to enrol more number of muslim children in future?

# Answer

### MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF MINORITY AFFAIRS (SHRI VINCENT H. PALA)

(a) Enrolment figures are not maintained community-wise. However, under the Prime Minister's new 15 Point Programme for the welfare of the minorities, scholarships are awarded to eligible students belonging to the five notified minority communities including Muslims from Class - I onwards. Since the inception of the scholarship schemes, the number of Muslim students who have benefitted from the respective schemes is as follows:-
