- (b) & (c): At present, Rail Travellers' Service Agents (RTSAs) are authorized to collect service charges @ Rs. 15/- per passenger in case of reserved Second Sitting (2S) and Sleeper (SL) classes and @ Rs. 25/- per passenger in case of other classes. These charges are considered adequate.
