(a) to (d): Yes Sir. The revised Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) "Vocationalisation of Higher Secondary Education" was approved by the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) on 15.9.2011 for imparting vocational education in Classes XI-XII. Pilot projects in Class IX have also been approved within the Scheme for implementation in Haryana and West Bengal. The sectors selected are Retail, IT, Automobile and Security. Proposals from 7 States, including Haryana and West Bengal, under the revised Scheme have been received by the Ministry.
