Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether certain difficulties are being faced by the retired Government servants in using the facilities provided by the empanelled hospitals;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government is considering to make CGHS treatment easier by allowing the retired Government servant to go directly to the empanelled hospitals without seeking the formal reference other than emergency from the area dispensaries;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether the Government also proposes to make CGHS more userfriendly by providing better medical attendance free of cost to its retired employees through OPD of the empanelled hospital; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?
