(a)to(c) The National Action Plan on Climate Change (NAPCC) released by the Prime Minister on 30th June 2008 outlines eight Missions namely National Solar Mission, National Mission for Enhanced Energy Efficiency, National Mission on Sustainable Habitat, National Water Mission, National Mission for Sustaining the Himalayan Ecosystem, National Mission for a 'Green India', National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture and National Mission on Strategic Knowledge for Climate Change. The Missions are to be institutionalised by the Nodal Ministries who are to prepare the Mission documents and obtain approval of the Prime Minister's Council on Climate Change. Mission documents are at various stages of finalisation

(d) & (e) Coordination meetings have been taken at various levels in the Government to finalise the Missions.
