(a)to(c) No,Sir. Government has not formulated any scheme to provide special security to important cultural and religious places in the country. However, Archaeological Survey of India has been providing security to all of its protected Monuments, Museums, Sites, through Armed Police Guards, Home Guards and private security guards, in addition to its regular attendants. On Supreme Court's Order, special security arrangements have been made through Central Industrial Security Force (CISF) in Red Fort and Taj Mahal
