USE OF STADIA

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the top sports stadia set up in Delhi have been thrown open for the use of Government universities, schools, corporate bodies as well as registered societies;
- (b) if so, the names of such stadia and the criteria fixed for offering these stadia to the above; and
- (c) if not, the time by which the said stadia are likely to be opened?

Answer

(a) to (c): Yes, Madam. Sports Authority of India (SAI) is managing the following five Stadia in Delhi:-

- (i) Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium Complex.
- (ii) Indira Gandhi Stadium Complex.
- (iii) Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Swimming Pool Complex.
- (iv) Major Dhyan Chand National Stadium.
- (v) Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges.

These Stadia are being utilized for sports activities by various Universities/Schools/Corporate Bodies etc. Training under "Come & Play" Scheme to sportspersons is also being imparted in all Stadia.
