- (a) whether there has been a huge increase in the quantity of apples being imported from China;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) the details of the impact of such imports on the domestic apple harvesters; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government to protect the interests of apple harvesters in India?

(a)&(b) Import of apples is 'free' under Exim Code 08081000 of ITC (HS) Classifications for Export and Import items. Details of total import of apples and percentage share of apples imported from China during the last 3 years are as under:

Year Total Imports Imports from China % Share of China (Value in Rs. Crores) (Value in Rs. Crores)

2008-2009 322.43 114.93 35.55

2009-2010 434.60 161.58 37.17

2010-2011 622.67 256.77 41.28

(c)&(d) The applied rate of basic customs duty on apples is 50% which is the maximum rate that India can maintain on this item as per its bound rate commitments in WTO.
