- (b) if so, the name of the scheme started in its place alongwith the details thereof;
- (c) whether the labourers of the unorganized sector have deposited their share of money under the contributory scheme;
- (d) if so, the amount deposited in the States during the last three years; and
- (e) the details of utilization of the contributory fund?
