Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the State-wise total number of male and female beedi workers in the country as on date;
- (b) whether inspite of various welfare schemes being implemented for them, they continue to face certain problems specially with regard to health and medical facilities;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government to redress their grievances;
- (d) whether the Government is considering to open some more hospitals in the districts dominated by beedi workers including Beena city of Madhya Pradesh;
- (e) if so, the details thereof;
- (f) whether the Government has carried out any assessment regarding the number of beedi workers who lost their jobs during each of the past three years and the current year; and
- (g) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government to rehabilitate them and providing them jobs again?

Answer

MINISTER OF LABOUR & EMPLOYMENT (SHRI MALLIKARJUN KHARGE)

- (a): The details are at Annexure-I.
- (b)&(c): Improvement in health care facilities is an ongoing process. A decision has also been taken to cover Beedi Workers under Rashtriya Swasthya Bima Yojana.
- (d)&(e): No such proposal is under consideration for Beena city in Madhya Pradesh. However recently, Government has sanctioned 4 Hospitals and 40 dispensaries for Beedi Workers in such places where there is concentration of beedi workers.
- (f)&(g): No such assessment has been carried out. However, the Government has initiated action for providing vocational training to Beedi Workers to provide them an opportunities for alternative source of employment.
