(a) to (c) The Government has not received any proposal from the States for qualitative and quantitative assessment of development work in catchment areas in border areas of the country. However, on recommendations made by the Committee on Special Remedial Works constituted by the Central Water Commission, Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) provides grants-in-aid to the Government of Punjab for undertaking flood protection measures on Sutlej and Ravi rivers with the primary aim of protecting Border Security Force (BSF) assets like Border Outposts (BOPs), Border Fencing etc.
