## Will the Minister of FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received any proposal to develop and promote food processing units in rural areas of the country, especially in Karnataka;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of funds provided for the purpose during the last three years?

## THE MINISTER OF FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES(SHRI SUBODH KANT SAHAI)

(a) to (c): Ministry of Food Processing Industries extends financial assistance in the form of grant-in-aid @ 25% of the cost of plant & machinery and technical civil works subject to a maximum of Rs. 50 lakhs in general areas or 33.33% subject to a maximum of Rs. 75 lakhs in difficult areas under the Scheme of Setting uplModernization/Expansion of food processing industries. This Scheme is project specific and the data on food processing in rural areas of the country, especially Kamataka is not centrally maintained by the Ministry. However, the financial assistance provided to the various units under the scheme in Kamataka during the last three years i.e. 2006-07, 2007-08 and 2008-09 is Rs.614.290 lakhs, Rs. 529.62 lakhs and Rs. 629.895 lakhs respectively.
