## Will the Minister of PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Staff Selection Commission (SSC) has taken a decision to further simplify the Government recruitment process through a Single Uniform Examination System for all the non-gazetted posts;

(b) if so, the salient features of the proposed system and the reasons therefor; and

(c) the extent to which this system is likely to prove beneficial for the applicants and the Government recruitment agency?

## Answer

Minister of State in the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions and Minister of State in the Prime Minister's Office. (SHRI V. NARAYANASAMY)

(a): The reforms in Examination system of the Staff Selection Commission (SSC) are decided by the Government. The SSC makes recruitment to non-gazetted posts under its purview by conducting All India Competitive Examination, Departmental Examinations and Interviews. The SSC has not taken any decision to make the recruitment to all non-gazetted posts through a single uniform examination system.

(b) & (c): Do not arise in view of (a) above.
