- (a) whether in view of coming Kumbh Mela, the Railways are proposing to alter the Rambagh Railway line in Allahabad and thereby facilitate the construction of rail overbridge;
- (b) if so, the reaction of the Railways thereto;
- (c) whether the Railways also propose to construct railway overbridges at Karchhana, Mirpur in Allahabad; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

(a) to (c): Yes, Madam. The work of construction of 2-lane Road Over Bridge (ROB) in lieu of level crossing No.T-1/B at Allahabad Junction has been sanctioned in 2011-12 on cost sharing basis between Railway and State Govt. of Uttar Pradesh. Presently, site inspection, planning and estimation is in progress.

Road Over Bridges in lieu of five level crossings (LC No.27, 29, 30, 31 & 32) situated between Karchhana and Mirpur have been included in Railway Works Programme 2012-13.
