SUPPLY OF LONG LASTING INSECTICIDAL NETS

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has supplied Long Lasting Insecticidal Nets (LLINs) under the World Bank assisted Malaria Control Project to the State Governments;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the present status of supply of Long Lasting Insecticidal Nets to the States, State/UT-wise;
- (d) whether the said assistance has not been provided to a number of States including Gujarat; and
- (e) if so, the reasons therefor alongwith the time by which supply of Long Lasting Insecticidal Nets (LLINs) is likely to be made to them?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI SUDIP BANDYOPADHYAY)

(a)to(c): Yes. A total of 51,79,114 Nos. of LLINs have been supplied during 2011-12 to the States of Andhra Pradesh (1,005,866), Chhattisgarh (903,040), Jharkhand (660,000), Madhya Pradesh(707,540) & Orissa(1,902,668).

(d)&(e): LLINs are supplied to Project States only. Gujarat is one of the project states in phase II of the Project and has been included in the list of LLIN consignee states in 2012-13.
