UPGRADATION OF SECONDARY HEALTH CARE SYSTEM

(a) whether the Government proposes to utilize world Bank assistance of upgradation of secondary health care system under the State Health care Projects in rural hospitals; and

(b) if so, the State-wise details of financial assistance provided by the Government for hospital projects in the country during the last three years?

(a)&(b): The World Bank is currently funding State Health Systems Development Projects in Rajasthan, Karnataka and Tamil Nadu. Sanctioned loan amount for the Karnataka, Health System Dev. & Reforms Projects is Rs. 725.17 Crores (approx.), Rajasthan Health System Development Project is Rs. 455.06 Crores (approx.), Tamilnadu Health System Project is Rs. 566.67 Crore, (approx.) and additional financing for Tamil Nadu Health System Project is Rs. 598.22 Crores (approx.). These projects include enhancement of the capacity of pre-existing health facilities at district and sub district levels.
