(a) & (b) Development of Brackish water Aquaculture is one of the components of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme `Development of Inland Fisheries and Aquaculture`. Various States of the country including Orissa can take-up this component for implementation for which financial assistance is shared between the Centre and State in a proportion of 75:25. However, no funds have been allocated under this component during the last three years and the current year so far.
