Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the condition of roads from Jhansi to Bemata on NH-76 and from Kanpur to Dewas on NH-84 passing through Madhya Pradesh, is in a very dilapidated condition;
- (b) if so, whether the Government is taking any steps for the repair of these
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the time by which the repairing of these stretches is likely to be completed?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI JITIN PRASADA)

(a) to (d) The road from Jhansi to Bamitha is not NH-76 but it is NH-75. The condition of NH-75 in Uttar Pradesh is in motor able condition and the portion in Madhya Pradesh is not in good condition. Madhya Pradesh PWD is making efforts to maintain this National Highway in traffic worthy condition. There is no National Highway connecting Kanpur directly to Dewas. There are more than one alternative route which connect Kanpur to Dewas. One of the national highways, NH-86 traverses from Kanpur to Bhopal and then from Bhopal there is a State highway which leads to Dewas. NH-86 is in motor able condition except in some isolated stretches in Madhya Pradesh, for which efforts are made by NHAI to improve the condition.
