**Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the vehicles/daily commuters going towards Uttarakhand and other areas of Western Uttar Pradesh have to face lots of difficulties due to daily traffic jams at Modi Nagar on NH-58;
- (b) if so whether the Government proposes to construct a by-pass at Modi Nagar;
- (c) if so, the time by which the said by-pass is likely to be constructed; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

**Answer**

(b) to (d) To ease traffic jam at Modi Nagar on NH-58, widening of existing National Highway 58 up to Meerut besides construction of flyover are being proposed. Six laning of NH-58 from Delhi/UP Border up to Meerut is a part of Delhi-Meerut Expressway under National Highway Development Project(NHDP) Phase -VI to be implemented by National Highways Authority of India(NHAI). Final Feasibility Report for the same has been submitted by the consultant.
