(a) whether frequent accidents/mishaps are taking place at Lonavla on the Mumbai-Pune Expressway;

(b) if so, the number of accidents occurred during the last three months at this place; and

(c) the steps taken/being taken by the Government for the safety of people?

(a) & (b) No, Sir. However, at Lonavla exit/Kusagaon toll Naka, there is a junction and sharp curve on the road but not a single accident has occurred at that particular place during the period from January 2012 and up to 20th March, 2012.

(c) Government of Maharashtra is taking the following steps to prevent the accidents on Mumbai-Pune expressway:-

(i) Informatory sign boards, crash barrier, fixing iron fence, building safety wall on both side of road end including fixing reflector on safety wall and painting a middle line on the road have been provided.

(ii) 24 hour patrolling of policemen and highway police is being done.

(iii) Two stand by ambulances have been provided at different locations of Mumbai-Pune expressway.

(iv) Round the clock helpline numbers have been provided.
