(c)&(d): The Draft Rehabilitation Scheme (DRS) for revival of closed units of Hindustan Fertilizer Corporation Limited (HFCL) & Fertilizer Corporation of India Limited (FCIL) are currently under consideration of BIFR. The scheme envisages putting up of 1.15 MTPA Urea Plant at each of the existing locations through a process of awarding units to PSUs on nomination basis and to other private entities through bidding process. Funds will be arranged by the nominated PSUs and successful bidders.
