Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of primary, upper primary and secondary school buildings sanctioned under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) during each of the last three years and the current year, State-wise;
- (b) the number of such buildings constructed during the above period, State-wise;
- (c) the details of funds provided to each State/UT for this purpose during the above period; and
- (d) the number of such buildings proposed to be constructed during 2012-13 alongwith the proposed allocations therefor; State-wise?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. D. PURANDESWARI)

(a) to (c) A State-wise statement on the number of primary and upper primary schools sanctioned and constructed under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) and funds provided for construction activities during each of the last three years and the current year is at Annexure-I. A State-wise statement on the number of new secondary schools sanctioned under Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA) since inception and those constructed/in-progress together with funds provided for civil works including construction of new secondary school buildings, strengthening of infrastructure of existing secondary schools etc. during the above period is at Annexure-II.

(d) Under SSA, the requirement of these facilities are worked out by the States/UTs based on need at school/village/block and district level, and reflected in their Annual Work Plan and Budget (AWP&B). Project Approval Board (PAB) meetings to consider AWP&B for 2012-13 in respect of all the States/UTs are in progress in the Ministry. Under RMSA, 3956 new secondary schools approved during 2011-12 are proposed to be constructed during 2012-13, as detailed in Annexure-II.
