(a) to (c): While the Government have decided to convert the Institute of Technology, Banaras Hindu University (IT-BHU), in Uttar Pradesh, to an Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), there is no proposal at present to convert any other reputed Institute to an IIT or an NIT (National Institute of Technology).
