MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. D.PURANDESWARI)

(a) to (c) Ministry of Human Resource Development is not administering the scheme for opening of Navyug and Pratibha Vikas Vidyalayas. These come under the purview of Government of NCT of Delhi and respective State Governments. Kendriya Vidyalayas are opened primarily to cater to the education needs of the wards of transferable Central Government Employees including Defence personnel and not on the criteria of State-wise/District-wise/Block-wise/minority dominated area-wise etc.
