(a) and (b): Yes, Madam. Hotel and Tourism sector is declared as high priority sector and Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) upto 100%, under the automatic route is permitted in 'Hotels & Tourism Sector', subject to applicable laws/regulations, security and other conditionalties.
