Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of roads built under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana in the district of Khargone and Barwani of Madhya Pradesh during the last three years and the current year;
- (b) whether the works on these roads have been completed;
- (c) if not, the action taken against the contractors who could not complete the work;
- (d) whether tenders have again been invited by the Government to get the uncompleted works done;
- (e) if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI PRADEEP JAIN `ADITYA`)

(a) to (f): Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) is an on going scheme. The responsibility of implementation of the scheme lies with the State Government. Further, funds under PMGSY are released taking the State as a unit and district-wise data is not maintained centrally. As reported by the State, 518 roads were built under PMGSY in the districts of Khargone and Barwani in Madhya Pradesh during last three years and the current year. Out of above, 420 roads have been completed by the State. Contracts for four roads have been terminated by the State and fresh tendering process has been initiated.
