(a) & (b): Yes Madam. The following Stadia of Sports Authority of India (SAI) in Delhi were renovated/upgraded for hosting the Commonwealth Games 2010 where State of Art facilities for various games are available at par with international standards:i) Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium Complex.

ii) Indira Gandhi Stadium Complex.

iii) Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Swimming Pool Complex.

iv) Major Dhyan Chand National Stadium.

v) Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges.

These stadia are being used by various Sports Federations as well as by National/International level sportspersons.

Apart from above, a new scheme i.e. "Come & Play" has also been introduced for the general public to avail the facilities of International standards. National Coaching Camps are also being arranged in these stadia so that budding sportspersons could achieve excellence in sports.

(c) & (d): Well trained coaches are provided in the above said stadia for each sports discipline. The details of coaches posted at various SAI Stadia are as under:-
